HEALTH AND SAFETY:

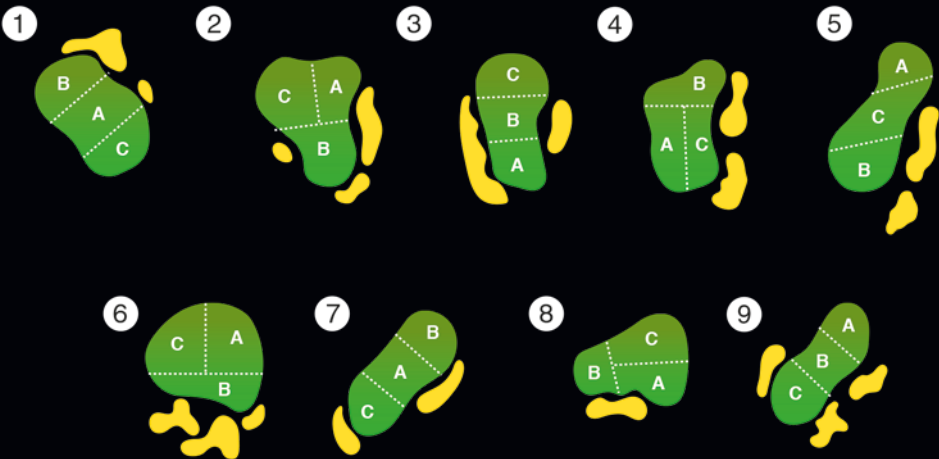
To ensure that your round of golf is as safe and enjoyable as possible, please adhere to the following:

- Please take care when attempting to retrieve golf balls from water hazards. Banks can be steep and may cause you to slip into the hazard. Floatation rings are situated at all deep-water areas.
- Beware of other golfers and also beware of golf balls from players following you.
- Beware of rabbit and foxholes.

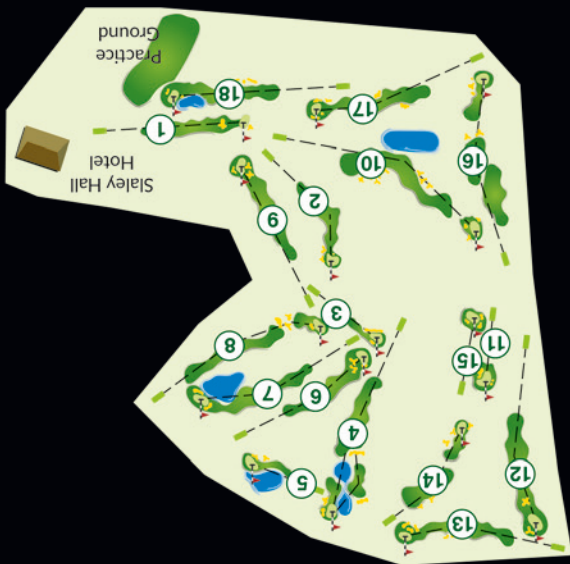
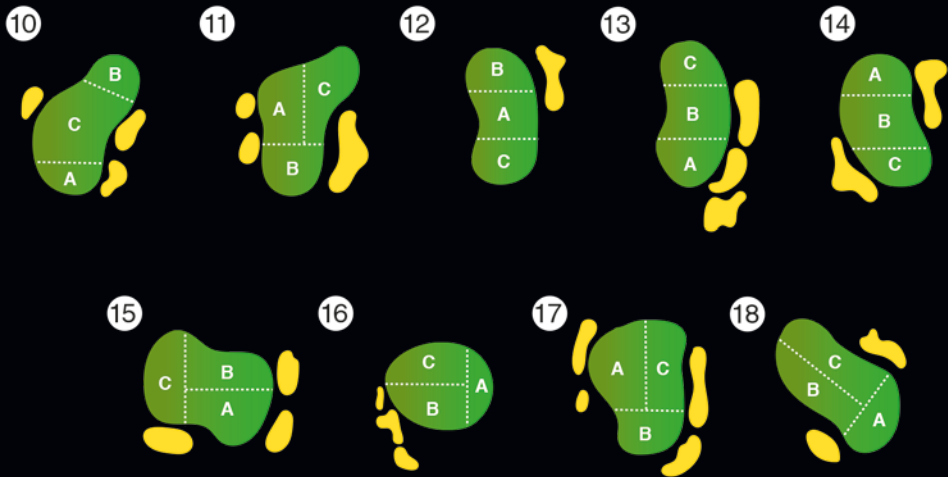
- Watch out for varying slopes on tees and greens.
- Beware of low branches when entering wooded areas.
- Take care when driving buggies and read instructions displayed on buggy windscreen.
- Keep to paths wherever possible.

The use of these devices on the course is not permitted. Please observe the Rules of Golf, in particular Section 1.

PORTABLE TELEPHONES

Golfers must keep strictly to the rules displayed in each cart. They should note in particular that only the driver and one passenger are allowed.

BUGGIES

Stroke Play - Two Strokes.
Match Play - Loss of Hole;

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Please observe the rules of golf and pay particular attention to Section 1 of those rules. Consideration should be shown to other players.
Holes and footprints in bunkers must be raked. Divots must be replaced. Pitch and spike marks repaired. Avoid slow play at all times and maintain your place on the course. The target time for a complete round is four hours.

ETIQUETTE

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS
Bridges, yardage discs, markers and all roads and pathways. (Rule 24-2 applies). Protection of young trees identified by staking. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
All fixed sprinkler heads and water system covers are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition if such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green of the

HAZARDS

Beyond all fences, walls or hedges bounding the course, or beyond any lines of white posts acting as boundary markers. (Defs. and Rule 27 apply).

LOCAL RULES

GROUND UNDER REPAIR - G.U.R.
Play is prohibited from all newly seeded/turfed areas (with the exception of seeded divots from which relief is not allowed). If a player's ball lies in such an area or if such an area of G.U.R. interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing the player must take relief under Rule 25-1. All tyre and tractor marks may be classed as G.U.R. and relief may be taken as prescribed in Rule 25-1(b).

MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24-1 applies.

hole being played intervenes on the line between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief, without penalty, as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club-lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.
