NAME OF STANDARD: Members Pairs – The Doug Blewitt Tankards

WHY THIS IS A QUALITY STANDARD:

To ensure the competition is organised and run correctly and to the same basic requirement each year.

HOW THE QUALITY STANDARD IS TO BE ACHIEVED:

1. The Competition is for Members of The Golf Club
2. To be played as an 18-hole 4 ball better ball competition.
3. Maximum individual course handicap, men 28, ladies 36
4. Playing handicap is 90% course handicap
5. Full difference from the lowest.
6. Played from the White Tees for men and Red Tees for ladies
7. Draw to be made on the last Friday in April
8. All entries must be made and paid for prior to this date
9. Both pairs of players are responsible for arranging and playing the match by the specified date.
10. Players should inform the Captain or member of the committee of any game that has not been arranged within one week prior to the specified closing date to help progress the situation.
11. If a player has a legitimate reason for not meeting the required deadline date, they must as soon as possible put their case to The Captain/Committee, who will decide to grant an extension or award the tie.
12. If a match finishes 'all square' after 18 holes, sudden death will be played, handicap allowance to be re applied.
13. If a mutual agreement cannot be made regarding the course to be played, then the decision will be made by the spin of a coin, Heads = Hunting, Tails = Priestman
14. Course Adjustment Shots

HUNTING red tees receive +1.4 course adjustment shots

PRIESTMAN red tees receive +2.0 course adjustment shots

These are to be added to the PLAYING HANDICAP.
