NAME OF STANDARD: Gentlemen's Matchplay – The Brown Minorities Trophy

WHY THIS IS A QUALITY STANDARD:

To ensure the competition is organised and run correctly and to the same basic requirement each year.

HOW THE QUALITY STANDARD IS TO BE ACHIEVED:

1. The Competition is for Gentlemen Members of The Golf Club
2. To be played as 18-hole match play competition between May and September inclusive.
3. Maximum individual playing handicap 28.
4. Full handicap difference, based upon **COURSE HANDICAP**. Lowest handicap to play off zero, the higher course handicap will get the full difference in shots.
E.g. if course handicaps are 10 and 15, the lowest handicapped golfer plays off zero, and the higher handicapped golfer will get the full difference (10-5) 5 shots on stroke index holes 1 to 5
5. Played from the White Tees.
6. Draw to be made on the last Friday in April
7. All entries with payment must be made prior to this date
8. Both players are responsible for arranging and playing the match by the specified date.
9. Players should inform the Captain or member of the committee of any game that has not been arranged within one week prior to the specified closing date to help progress the situation.
10. If a player has a legitimate reason for not meeting the required deadline date, they must as soon as possible put their case to The Captain/Committee, who will decide to grant an extension or award the tie.
11. If a match finishes 'all square' after 18 holes, sudden death will be played, handicap allowance to be re applied.
12. If a mutual agreement cannot be made regarding the course to be played, then the decision will be made by the spin of a coin, Heads = Hunting, Tails = Priestman
